CANDIDATE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS & DEADLINE TO FILE		
CANDIDATE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS	DEADLINE TO FILE CANDIDATE APPLICATION***	
<p>The requirements/qualifications to serve on the Fate City Council are found in the Home Rule Charter: Sec. 3.02. - Qualifications.</p> <p>(1) A candidate for City Council must be 21 years of age at the time of filing for the election.</p> <p>(2) A Candidate for City Council must be a City resident for at least 12 continuous months at the time of filing for the election.</p> <p>(3) A Council member must maintain residence in the City of Fate during their term of office. For purposes of subsections (2) and (3) of this Section 3.02, a person must meet all of the following to meet the requirements to "be a City resident" or "maintain residence" in the City:</p> <p>(A) The person must use the residence address for voter registration and driver's license purposes;</p> <p>(B) The person must use the residence address as the person's home address on documents such as employment records, resumes, government forms and loan applications;</p> <p>(C) The person must not claim a homestead exemption on any property other than the residence.</p> <p>(4) A candidate for City Council must be a qualified voter of the City of Fate.</p> <p>(5) No Council member shall hold any other City office or City employment while serving as Council member.</p> <p>(6) The office of an incumbent elected City official shall become vacant when the person holding such office files an application to be placed on an official ballot as a candidate for any elective public office other than the one the person holds, unless otherwise prohibited by law.</p>	February 18, 2022 by 5:00 p.m.	
<p>Candidates are strongly encouraged to obtain a candidate packet. Candidate forms are available on the Secretary of State website, but the full Candidate Packet (recommended) is available in the City Secretary's Office the first week of January.</p> <p>***The filing period begins on the 108th day prior to the election date and ends on the 78th day at 5 p.m. prior to the election date.</p>
